

Multi IFR Rating

The Multi Engine Instrument Rating allows a pilot to operate a multi engine aircraft under Instrument Flight Rules.

This Training Cost is based on the following assumptions:

- Student has completed the Private Pilot License
- Student has completed the Multi-Engine Rating
- Student has a minimum of 50 hours of PIC cross-country time

To hold this rating a person must have reached 16 years of age, obtain a Category 3 medical certificate.
